

Welcome to the Wausau Prospectors Metal Detecting Day Outing to Central Wisconsin

This Outing will take place West of Dorchester Wisconsin on a farm field where a resident's once was in the early 1900's. Site to be announced as there are a couple of options depending on farm field's use for the spring.

The families that lived on these farms did not have much money and the buildings are gone. Some foundation pieces will be in the plowed fields. You are likely to find old trash from the early 1900's. Remember that one person's trash is another person's treasure. It is always possible to find coins.

Saturday May 12th Activities:

9 a.m. To 4 p.m. We will meet on Bridge Road about 7 miles straight west of Dorchester Wisconsin. From Dorchester take HWY A and go west 5 miles. You will come to HWY E. Keep going west for about 2 more miles on Bridge Road. HWY A and Bridge Road are the same road. Watch for the Wausau Prospectors sign.

Bring your own lunch, beverages, metal detector, digging tools, and a chair. **No bathroom facilities are available at this time so provide your own port-a-pail or go in the field.**

Note: You must fill in your holes after each dig.
