Located 2 miles off Co. Rd. CC on Co. Rd. HH near Plum City, WI. From the Twin Cities: exit 1-94E at Hwy 63S to Hwy 72E. From Eau Claire: exit 1-94W at Hwy 128S to Hwy 29W. From Red Wing: Hwy 63N to Hwy 10E or 72E.
